KIRK MACDONALD – HEAD COACH

Kirk MacDonald is entering his first season as head coach of the Wilkes-Barre/Scranton Penguins. He was hired as the 12th head coach in team history on July 16, 2024.

MacDonald, 41, has spent 11 seasons as a coach after wrapping up a six-year professional playing career. His first coaching job was at his alma mater, Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, as an assistant coach in 2013-14. He quickly transitioned to the Reading Royals of the ECHL, serving as an assistant coach for three seasons before being promoted to head coach and director of hockey operations four seasons. In his fourth and final season as Royals head coach (2021-22), the team went 45-17-7-2 and tied the franchise record with 99 points in a single season. Overall with Reading, MacDonald's squads went 155-86-25-9 (.625).

MacDonald, who hails from Victoria, British Columbia, then became the head coach of Dubuque Fighting Saints in the United States Hockey League for 2022-23 and 2023-24. In the latter campaign, MacDonald led Dubuque to the best record in the USHL's Eastern Conference, going 41-13-8 in the regular season before capturing the Eastern Conference Championship and making the Clark Cup Final.

A forward in his playing days, MacDonald attended R.P.I. from 2002-07. However, his collegiate career stalled when he was diagnosed with testicular cancer in April of 2005. After a grueling recovery that required several surgeries and chemotherapy treatments, he returned to captain the Engineers for his senior year. During that 2006-07 season, he ultimately led the team in goals (12) and points (27).

As a pro, he logged 272 AHL games with the Albany River Rats, Providence Bruins, Iowa Chops and Houston Aeros. MacDonald amassed 106 points (45G-61A) in that time. Furthermore, he appeared in 134 ECHL games for Reading and the Florida Everblades, picking up 111 points (51G-60A). He helped the Royals capture their first and only Kelly Cup in 2013, scoring the series-clinching goal in the Eastern Conference Final.

SHELDON BROOKBANK – ASSISTANT COACH

Sheldon Brookbank returns for his third season as Penguins assistant coach, but this is his eighth season behind the bench overall. Brookbank, 44, spent parts of the four seasons as an assistant coach in the NHL for the Chicago Blackhawks from 2018-2021. The native of Lanigan, Saskatchewan was hired to his current post by Wilkes-Barre/Scranton on Aug. 5, 2022.

Brookbank had a 16-year pro playing career, during which he racked up 853 games at the ECHL, AHL, NHL and KHL levels. 351 of those contests were logged in the NHL, where he suited up for Chicago, the Nashville Predators, New Jersey Devils and Anaheim Ducks. Brookbank, an undrafted free agent, hoisted the Stanley Cup as a player for Chicago in 2013.

He appeared in 367 AHL games with the Grand Rapids Griffins, Milwaukee Admirals, Cincinnati Mighty Ducks, Lowell Devils and Cleveland Monsters. He won the Eddie Shore Award as the AHL's best defenseman in 2006-07 with Milwaukee, when he led all league blueliners with 38 assists and 53 points.

Brookbank's brother, Wade, spent two seasons (2006-07, 2009-10) as a player with Wilkes-Barre/Scranton, recording eight points (4G-4A) and 284 penalty minutes in 107 games.

NICK LUUKKO – ASSISTANT COACH

Luukko, 33, steps behind the bench for the Penguins for the first time, standing alongside a long-time ally in Kirk MacDonald. A sixth-round draft pick by the Philadelphia Flyers in 2010, MacDonald was on the bench as an assistant when Luukko embarked on his first pro season with the Reading Royals in 2015-16. After a four-year pro career, Luukko joined a now-head coach MacDonald's staff as an assistant for the Royals in 2019-20.

The West Chester, Pennsylvania native spent the past three seasons as the head coach and director of hockey operations for the Jacksonville Icemen of the ECHL. In those three seasons, the Icemen went 126-73-17 (.623). Luukko shepherded his team to a 44-win season in 2022-23, establishing a new club record.

In his four seasons of professional hockey, Luukko logged 274 ECHL games, all with Reading. The right-hand shot defenseman posted 25 goals and 62 assists for 87 points. He also appeared in seven career AHL games, all as a member of the Lehigh Valley Phantoms. Prior to turning pro, Luukko skated for four seasons at the University of Vermont, leading the team's blueliners in goals and points during his sophomore year. He also lifted the Clark Cup as USHL Champion with the Dubuque Fighting Saints in 2011.
