# **General Manager Ryan Martin**



Ryan Martin was named Assistant General Manager of the New York Rangers and General Manager of the Hartford Wolf Pack on August 25<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

Martin joined the Rangers organization after spending 16 seasons with the Detroit Red Wings organization (2005-06 – 2020-21). He spent eleven seasons (2010-11 – 2020-21) as the organization's Assistant General Manager. In that role, Martin spent eight seasons (2013-14 – 2020-21) as the General Manager of the Red Wings' AHL affiliate, the Grand Rapids Griffins. Under Martin's guidance, the Griffins won the 2017 Calder Cup and advanced to the Calder

Cup Playoffs in every season in which the annual postseason tournament took place.

While with the Red Wing's organization, Martin spent five seasons (2005-06 – 2009-10) as the team's Director of Hockey Administration. Martin was also a member of the Red Wings organization when the club won the Stanley Cup at the conclusion of the 2008-09 NHL season.

In addition to his work with the Red Wings, Martin served as a scout with USA Hockey for their World Junior Championship team in 2021. That team won a Gold Medal in the Edmonton bubble in January 2021.

Prior to beginning his career with the Red Wings, Martin worked in Denver, Colorado from 1999 through 2003 as an attorney. He also worked at KO Sports, Inc.

With the Rangers, Martin oversees all aspects of hockey operations with the Wolf Pack, including player personnel decisions, player development, contract negotiations, and player movement.

## **Director of Hockey Operations Joey Padmanabhan**



Joey Padmanabhan joined the Wolf Pack in October of 2024 as the club's Director of Hockey Operations. The native of Chicago, IL, graduated from Cornell in May, 2024. While at the Ivy League school, Padmanabhan served as the Student Director of Hockey Operations for the club's ECAC men's hockey team. During the 2023-24 season, with Padmanabhan serving as Student Director of Hockey Operations, the program won both an Ivy League and ECAC Championship. During his time at Cornell, Padmanabhan gained ample experience with the CAA Hockey Agency in Los Angeles and his hometown Chicago Blackhawks. With the Blackhawks, Padmanabhan worked in the hockey strategy department. On the ice, he played the 2021-22 season with the OJHL's Lindsay Muskies.

While with the Wolf Pack, Padmanabhan will assist with all aspects of hockey operations while also handling the day-to-day operations of the club.

# **Head Coach Grant Potulny**



Grant Potulny was named Head Coach of the Hartford Wolf Pack on June 27<sup>th</sup>, 2024. He is the eighth Head Coach in Hartford Wolf Pack franchise history.

Potulny came to the Wolf Pack after seven seasons as the Head Coach of Northern Michigan University (2017-18 – 2023-24). While Head Coach of the Wildcats, Potulny led the program to a 128-113-17 record over 258 games. The Wildcats won 20 games in back-to-back seasons, posting a record of 20-16-1 during the 2021-22 campaign and a record of 21-17-0 during the 2022-23 season. The Wildcats concluded the 2022-23 campaign by advancing to the CCHA Finals for the second time in three seasons.

Prior to joining the Wildcats for the 2017-18 season, Potulny spent eight seasons as an Assistant Coach at the University of Minnesota. During his time with the Golden Gophers, Potulny helped the program capture six regular-season conference titles and qualify for the NCAA Tournament on five occasions.

The native of Grand Forks, ND, also played for the Golden Gophers during a four-year NCAA career. He scored 116 points (68 g, 48 a) in 146 games, including a career-high 22 goals as a freshman during the 2000-01 season. His successful college career included helping the Golden Gophers to a pair of NCAA National Championships. Potulny was named the NCAA Tournament MVP in 2002, helping the program to a National Championship. The Golden Gophers repeated as National Champions in 2003, with Potulny earning MVP honors in the WCHA Tournament.

Following his collegiate career, Potulny played six seasons in the AHL. He appeared in 297 career games, scoring 145 points (73 g, 72 a) with the Binghamton Senators (2003-04 – 2006-07), Hershey Bears (2007-08), Springfield Falcons (2007-08), San Antonio Rampage (2008-09), and Norfolk Admirals (2008-09).

He was selected in the fifth round, 157th overall, by the Ottawa Senators in the 2000 NHL Entry Draft.

Internationally, Potulny has served as an Assistant Coach for Team USA at the IIHF World Junior Championship in 2013, 2017, 2018, and 2022. Team USA took home the Gold Medal with Potulny behind the bench in both 2013 and 2017.

## **Assistant Coach Jamie Tardif**



Jamie Tardif was named an Assistant Coach on Kris Knoblauch's staff with the Wolf Pack on August 29th, 2022.

Tardif came to the Wolf Pack after four years as an Assistant Coach with the OHL's Soo Greyhounds (2018-19 - 2021-22). During his time with the organization, the Greyhounds won 112 games over the course of three seasons and advanced to the playoffs in both the 2018-19 and 2021-22 seasons. The league did not hold playoffs during the 2019-20 season and did not play the 2020-21 campaign due to COVID-19.

Prior to joining the Greyhounds, Tardif spent the 2017-18 season as a Player/Assistant Coach with the Quad City Mallards of the ECHL. That season would mark the end of his lengthy playing career.

Tardif played 12 professional seasons, including eight in the American Hockey League. Over the course of 487 AHL games with the Manitoba Moose, Iowa Stars, Grand Rapids Griffins, Providence Bruins, and Rochester Americans, Tardif scored 267 career points (142 g, 125 a). He served as the captain of the Griffins during the 2009-10 and 2010-11 seasons and was named an AHL All-Star during the 2012-13 season as a member of the Bruins.

Tardif also appeared in two career NHL games, both coming with the Boston Bruins during the 2012-13 campaign. Tardif made his NHL debut on February 2nd, 2013 against the Toronto Maple Leafs.

In addition to his North American career, Tardif played three seasons for Adler Mannheim of the German DEL. He helped guide the club to a DEL Championship during the 2014-15 season, his first year overseas. He appeared in 104 games in the DEL over the course of three seasons, scoring 58 points (26 g, 32 a).

Tardif also won an OHL Championship during the 2005-06 season as a player with the Peterborough Petes and was named an ECHL All-Star in 2006-07 as a member of the Toledo Storm.

A native of Welland, Ontario, Tardif was selected in the fourth round, 112th overall, by the Calgary Flames in the 2003 NHL Entry Draft.

# **Assistant Coach Paul Mara**



Paul Mara was named an interim Assistant Coach on Steve Smith's staff with the Wolf Pack on December  $5^{th}$ , 2023. He was named a full-time Assistant Coach on Grant Potulny's staff on August  $22^{nd}$ , 2024.

Mara initially joined the New York Rangers organization as a Player Development Assistant on August 25<sup>th</sup>, 2023, before transitioning into his role as an assistant coach with the Hartford Wolf Pack.

Before joining the Rangers organization, Mara spent five seasons as the head coach of the Boston Pride of both the NWHL and PHF. During his tenure in Boston, Mara guided the Pride to the Isobel Cup Championship in both 2021 and 2022. He also led the team to a regular season championship during the 2019-20 campaign.

Mara was also behind the bench as an assistant coach with Team USA at the 2018 Winter Olympics for the U.S. Women's National Team. That team defeated Team Canada in the gold medal game to win the second-ever gold medal for the United States in women's ice hockey

(1998).

Mara was selected 7<sup>th</sup> overall by the Tampa Bay Lightning in the 1997 NHL Entry Draft. He went on to enjoy a 734-game NHL career. He played for the Montréal Canadiens, Anaheim Ducks, New York Rangers, Boston Bruins, Phoenix Coyotes, and Tampa Bay Lightning. Mara collected 253 career points (64 g, 189 a) in his regular-season career. He also appeared in 33 career Stanley Cup Playoff games, notching seven points (3 g, 4 a).

Mara was a member of the Rangers for three seasons, appearing in 156 games with the club during 2006-07, 2007-08, and 2008-09 campaigns.

## **Skills Development Coach Colin Downey**



Colin Downey joined the Hartford Wolf Pack as Skills Development Coach in the fall of 2022. A native of Morristown, New Jersey, Downey enjoyed an eight-year professional career in France after a successful college career.

As a junior, Downey played for the Boston Junior Bruins of the EJHL during the 2008-09 and 2009-10 seasons. He served as captain of the Bruins during the 2009-10 season, his last before moving on to the NCAA level.

Downey played four seasons of NCAA hockey at Bowdoin College, where he appeared in 100 career games and scored 118 career points (47 g, 71 a). While at Bowdoin, Downey was named a First Team All-Star in the NESCAC following the 2011-12 season, and a Second Team All-Star following the 2013-14 season.

Following his NCAA career, Downey would embark on an eight year professional career in France. Over the course of 216 games in France, Downey scored 93 goals and 130 assists for 223 career points. He most recently suited up for Tours during the 2021-22 season, where he scored 24 points (9 g, 15 a) in 22 games.

## **Video Coach Nielsson Arcibal**



Nielsson Arcibal was named the Video Coach for the Wolf Pack prior to the 2024-25 season. He replaced Chris Hoeler, who joined the parent New York Rangers (NHL).

Arcibal joined the Wolf Pack following two seasons with NCAA American International College in Springfield, MA. He spent the 2022-23 season as the program's Director of Hockey Operations before being named an Assistant Coach for the 2023-24 campaign.

Prior to joining the coaching ranks, Arcibal put together a strong resumé as a player. The native of San Diego, CA, played roller hockey until the age of 13 when he first made the switch to ice hockey. He then played two seasons (2005-06, 2006-07) with the Texas Tornado of the NAHL, scoring 63 points in 110 regular season games with the program. He then spent the 2007-08 season with the Des Moines Buccaneers of the USHL before heading to AIC for his collegiate career. Arcibal played four seasons with the Yellow Jackets, scoring 83 points (27 g, 56 a) in 135 career games. He also wore an "A" for the program as a junior in 2010-11 before serving as captain as a senior in 2011-12.

Following his collegiate career, Arcibal played eight regular season and three Kelly Cup Playoff games with the ECHL's South Carolina Stingrays at the end of the 2011-12 season. He spent the 2012-13 campaign in Sweden, playing for Nittorps IK of the HockeyEttan. He also had stops in the CHL with the St. Charles Chill (2013-14) and SPHL with the Columbus Cottonmouths (2013-14, 2014-15, 2016-17).

Arcibal returned to his roller hockey roots during his ice hockey career, representing the United States multiple times at the IIHF's Inline Hockey Championship. He won Gold with Team USA in both 2013 and 2017.

## **Goaltending Coach Brendan Burke**



Brendan Burke was named the Goaltending Coach for the Hartford Wolf Pack on August 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2024. He replaced Jeff Malcolm, who joined the parent New York Rangers (NHL) as their Goaltending Coach.

Prior to joining the Wolf Pack, Burke spent two seasons as the Goaltending Coach for the WHL's Portland Winterhawks.

Before that, Burke played four seasons at the University of Alberta (USports), amassing a 37-8-0 record with a .916 save percentage, 2.08 goals against average, and eight shutouts in 52 appearances.

Burke helped guide the Golden Bears to a USports University Cup Championship in 2017-18, leading the league in goals-against average with a 2.03 mark that season.

He also played five seasons in the WHL, suiting up for both the Winterhawks and Calgary Hitmen. The native of Scottsdale, AZ, posted an 88-31-11 record with a .906 save percentage, 2.83 goals against average, and 10 shutouts during that time.

Burke also won the 2016 OHL Championship and Memorial Cup with the London Knights in his one season in the league. He went 10-4-0 in 19 appearances with the Knights in 2015-16.

Burke is the son of former NHL goaltender Sean Burke, who currently serves as the Director of Goaltending for the NHL's Vegas Golden Knights. The elder Burke played five seasons in Hartford for the NHL's Whalers (1992-93 - 1996-97).
